



## **Richard C. Hokanson**

Richard C. Hokanson was born in 1936. Hokanson was involved with the Boy Scouts of America for 22 years during the 1960s, 70s and 80s and was a Scoutmaster in Troop No. 210. Troop 210 was sponsored by St. Pius X Catholic Church in Rochester. Hokanson was also involved with the Big Brothers program at the YMCA for many years, and refereed youth sports. In 1982 three former Boy Scouts from Troop 210 reported being sexually abused by Hokanson. He pleaded guilty to 1<sup>st</sup> degree sexual assault for abusing one of the boys and was sentenced to counseling and probation.

In 1995 Richard Hokanson was arrested again and charged with two counts of 2<sup>nd</sup> degree criminal sexual conduct after sexually abusing two 12-year-old boys. The abuse occurred in Hokanson's home between 1992 and 1994. He pled guilty to both counts. Hokanson was sentenced to six years in prison and 25 years probation. In 2007, while on parole, he was arrested for accessing child pornography on his computer. Hokanson received a 150 month prison sentence for the offense and was released in 2012.

Richard Hokanson currently lives in Faribault, Minnesota and has recently had two civil lawsuits brought against him by former Troop 210 Boy Scouts who were also victims of his serial abuse. Click here to read more in Hokanson's [Confidential File](#).
