To fill the two vacancies at St. Bernard's Parish in St. Paul (which resulted from the appointment of Father Emmanuel Kelsch, O.S.B., as pastor of Holy Name Parish near Wayzata, and from the withdrawal of Father Barnabas Laubach, O.S.B., who has been appointed chaplain at the Reformatory in St. Cloud), I would like to present to Your Excellency the following two priests of the community:

Most Reverend and dear Archbishop,

To replace the deceased Father Roderic Albers, O.S.B., as pastor of St. Boniface Parish in Hastings, Minnesota, I would like to present to Your Excellency for the canonical appointment as pastor, Father Lancelot Atsch, O.S.B. Father Lancelot was born in 1909 and was ordained in 1935, and he has had rather wide experience in the priesthood, serving as assistant in St. Bernard's Parish in St. Paul, in St. Benedict's Parish in New York City, as college chaplain here, as pastor of the local parish in Collegeville, and as chaplain, at present, at St. Mary's Hospital in Duluth. I believe that he will do well as pastor of St. Boniface's Parish in Hastings, and I have no hesitation in recommending him for the canonical appointment. If this is agreeable, I would be grateful if it were made effective on June 30.

If this is agreeable, I would leave Father Peregrin Berres, O.S.B., who has been in charge of the parish since the death of Father Roderic, as assistant, and I would be grateful if Your Excellency would approve of his reverting to the status of vicarious cooperator.

I would like to remove Father Aloysius Michels, O.S.B., from his position as assistant at St. Boniface Parish in Minneapolis, to name him pastor of St. Joseph Parish in St. Joseph, Minnesota, in this Diocese. To replace him as assistant at St. Boniface Parish in Minneapolis, I would like to present to Your Excellency Father Rupert Schreifels, O.S.B., who was born in 1910 and ordained in 1940. Father Rupert has served in our mission in Puerto Rico, and also as assistant at St. Bartholomew's Parish in Wayzata. I have no hesitation in recommending him as assistant at St. Boniface Parish in Minneapolis and in requesting for him the faculties of the Archdiocese. If this is agreeable, I would like to have the appointment be effective on August 24.

I would also like to remove Father Thomas Gillespie, O.S.B., from his position as assistant at St. Bernard's Parish in St. Paul so that he can assist our Director of Vocations here. To replace him, I would like to present to Your Excellency for the appointment as assistant at St. Bernard's Parish, Father Cajetan Palluck, O.S.B., who was ordained on May 14 of this year. He spent several weeks at St. Bernard's Parish as a deacon last summer, and I believe that he will do good work there. I have no hesitation in recommending him to Your Excellency for this appointment and for the grant of the faculties of the Archdiocese. If this is agreeable, I would be grateful if the appointment were made effective on August 5.

Archbishop Roach has received your letter of May 14 and he has asked me to respond on his behalf concerning personnel changes of the Benedictine Fathers and Brothers within the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis.

Archbishop Roach is pleased to approve your appointments of the following personnel:

The Reverend Mel Taylor, O.S.B., as Pastor of the Church of St. Bernard, St. Paul, effective July 1, 1976; the Reverend Thomas Gillespie, O.S.B., as Associate Pastor of the Church of St. Bernard, St. Paul, effective August 3, 1976; the Reverend Blane Wasnie, O.S.B., as Associate Pastor of the Church of St. Boniface, Hastings, effective June 1, 1976; the Reverend Stephen Beauclair, O.S.B., as Associate Pastor of the Church of St. Boniface, Hastings, effective June 1, 1976; the Reverend Virgil O'Neill, O.S.B. as Pastor of the Church of St. Mary, Stillwater, effective August 3, 1976; the Reverend Louis Patnode, O.S.B., as Chaplain at Benilde-St. Margaret High School, effective August 3, 1976; the Reverend Cyprian Weaver, O.S.B., to the faculty of Benilde-St. Margaret High School, effective this summer.

I also note that Brother Dominic Ruiz, O.S.B. and Brother Nathan Lebaire, O.S.B., are being assigned to Benilde-St. Margaret High School to do practice teaching.

When the new Pastors and Associate Pastors arrive at their assignments, I would ask that they call at the Chancery Office to make the customary Profession of Faith and to receive the Archdiocesan Pagella of Faculties. The faculties of the Archdiocese are granted to the priests effective on the beginning date of their assignments.

The Archbishop and all of us in the Archdiocese want to express our great gratitude to those Benedictine Fathers who are being reassigned outside the Archdiocese: Fathers Vernon Miller, Cloud Meinberg, Florian Muggli and Francis Studer. Their priestly ministry in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis has been most effective and greatly appreciated. Please thank them in the name of Archbishop Roach.

All seems to be well at St. Joseph's in Minneapolis, according to the reports from Father Barnabas. If it is agreeable to you, the Archdiocese would be grateful if Father Barnabas could stay on for some weeks to complete the closing of the old church.

Once again, the Archbishop is extremely grateful to Father Brnabas Laubach for his great and sensitive work at St. Joseph's.

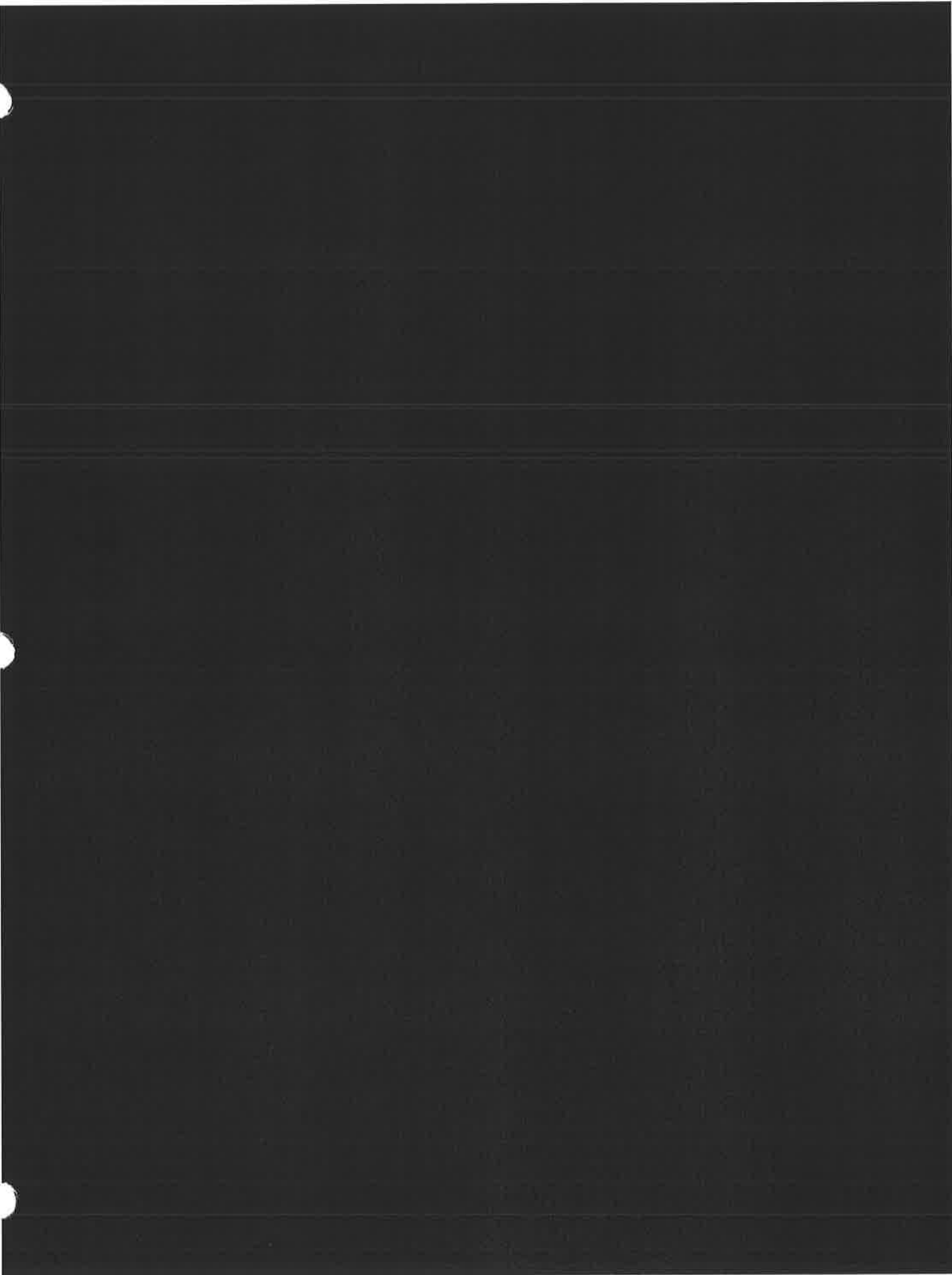

Archbishop Roach received your kind letter of May 26, 1978 in which you presented certain priests to be working within the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis.

The Archbishop is pleased to appoint Father Florian Muggli, O.S.B., as pastor of Saint Boniface parish in Hastings. The effective date will be June 15, 1978.

The Archbishop also gladly appoints Father Thomas Gillespie, O.S.B., as pastor of Saint Mary's Church in Stillwater with an effective date for the appointment being June 15, 1978.

Father Dunstan Mourse, O.S.B., is appointed as associate pastor at St. Bernard's parish in St. Paul. The effective date of this appointment will be June 15, 1978.

These priests will have the faculties of the Archdiocese as soon as they take up residence in the parishes where they will be serving. We will also have these appointment officially announced and published in the Catholic Bulletin of the Archdiocese.

We ask that when these priests arrive in the Archdiocese, they make an appointment to come to the Chancery to meet the Chancellor, Bishop Kinney, and to receive the pagella of faculties of the Archdiocese. They will be given any marriage certification they will need to be filed with the clerk of court so that they can perform marriages within the state. At the time of the visit they will also have the opportunity to visit with the Vicar for Religious for the Archdiocese.

We will be happy to welcome Brother Gordon Gandy, O.S.B., transitional deacon, who will be coming to the Archdiocese in September. Since there are special faculties for deacons, we ask that he also make an appointment to come down to the Chancery office to meet the people here. Father Dick Dorr who is working with the transitional deacons of the Archdiocese, will be glad to give him any assistance that he might want during his deaconal experience in the Archdiocese.


Dear Father Urban:

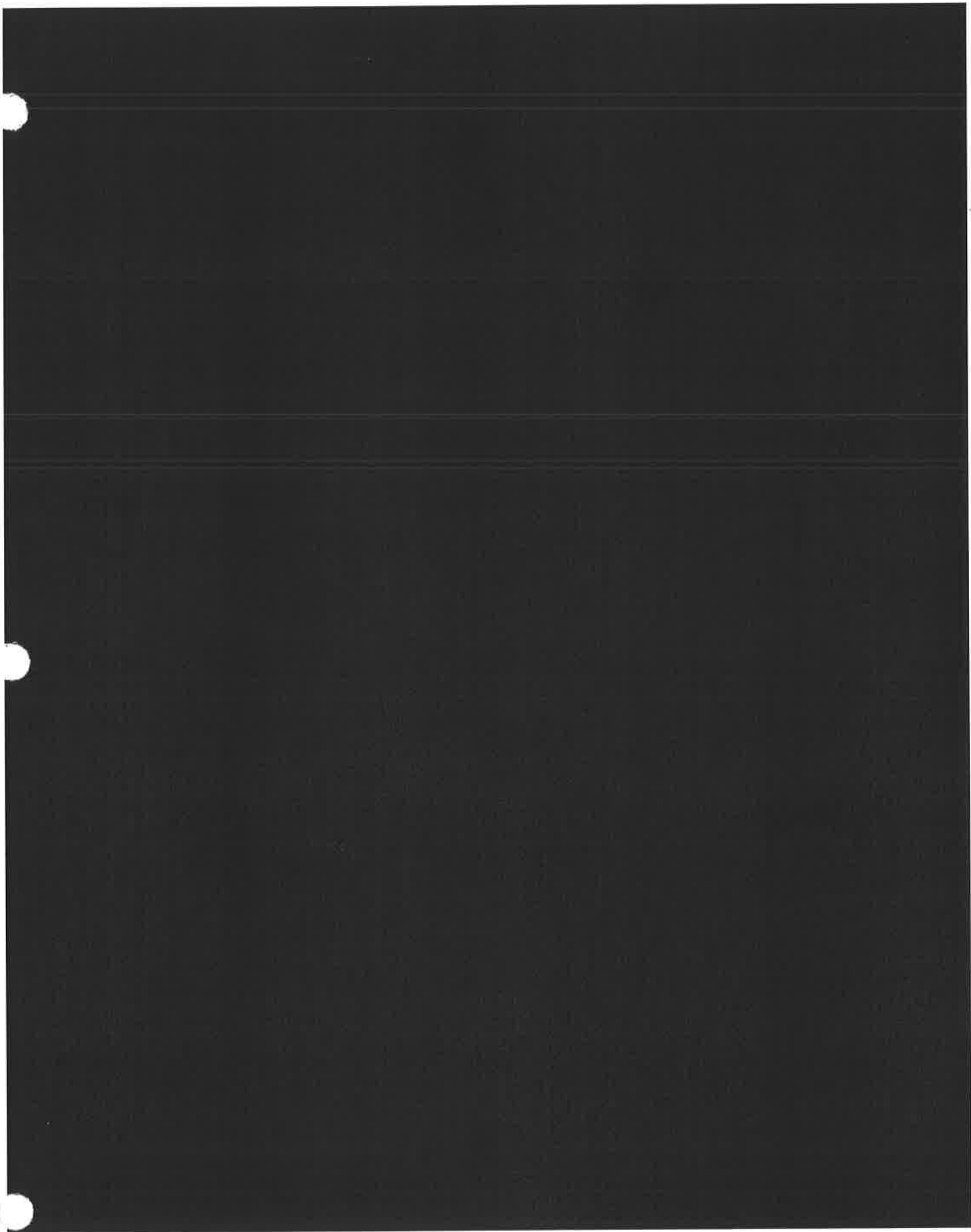
Because of all these circumstances, permission is denied for you to be present at this baptism.

Dear Counsel:

This letter is to advise you that I represent [REDACTED] who, for the first time in February, disclosed that he was sexually abused by Father Thomas Gillespie when he was [REDACTED] years old. [REDACTED] came to know Father Gillespie at St. Bernard's parish. The sexual abuse occurred when Father Gillespie was assigned to St. Mary's parish in Stillwater.

[REDACTED] has also just disclosed that when he was approximately [REDACTED] years old, he was sexually abused by Fr. Cosmos Dahlheimer. Fr. Cosmos Dahlheimer was assigned to St. Bernard's parish at the time of the abuse.

[REDACTED] is in need of therapy and has had an initial appointment with [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] would like to continue in therapy with [REDACTED], however, his insurance does not cover that therapy. Since both priests are priests of the Order of St. Benedict, serving within the Archdiocese at the time of the abuse, I make a joint request of the Order and Archdiocese to cover the therapy expenses of [REDACTED]. Certainly, we would agree to the standard arrangements regarding payment if this request is granted.




Dear Mr. Klukas:

I received your proposal for the payment of counseling of [REDACTED]. The frequency, the nature, and the extent of the counseling cannot really be pre-ordained under the circumstances. Therefore, we cannot agree to any set amount at this time because that should be something determined by the treating therapist and the patient. Second, it is unrealistic to have the treatment notes forwarded with the bills contemporaneously. We are willing and able to assemble, at various periods, the treatment records and forward them to you.

Finally, we would agree that the payment of any counseling expenses would not be used offensively or defensively by any party in connection with litigation. If there is any ultimate settlement, that amount would be reduced by the amount of therapy expense paid to that date.

We will in the near future be providing you with more detailed information concerning the sexual molestations.

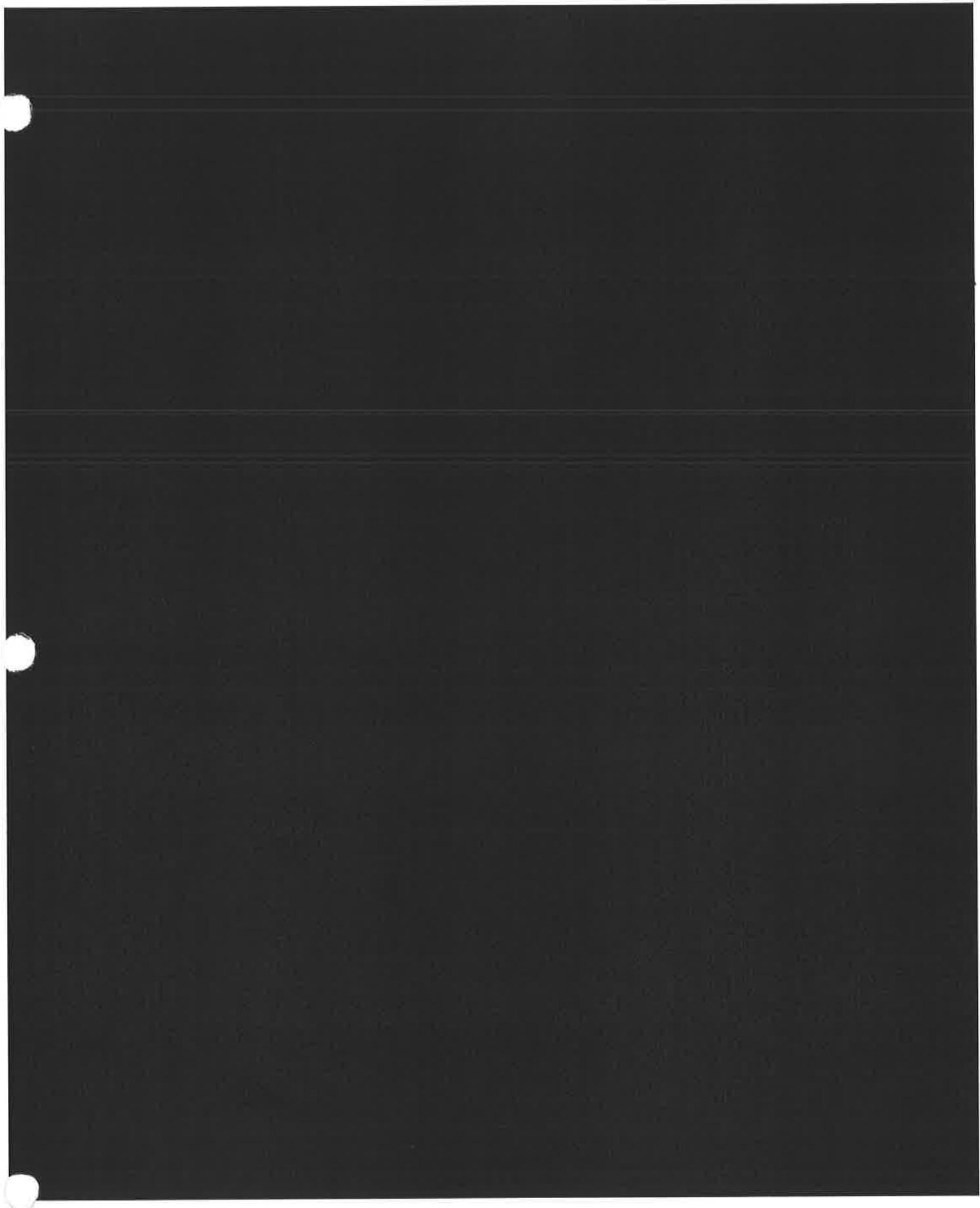

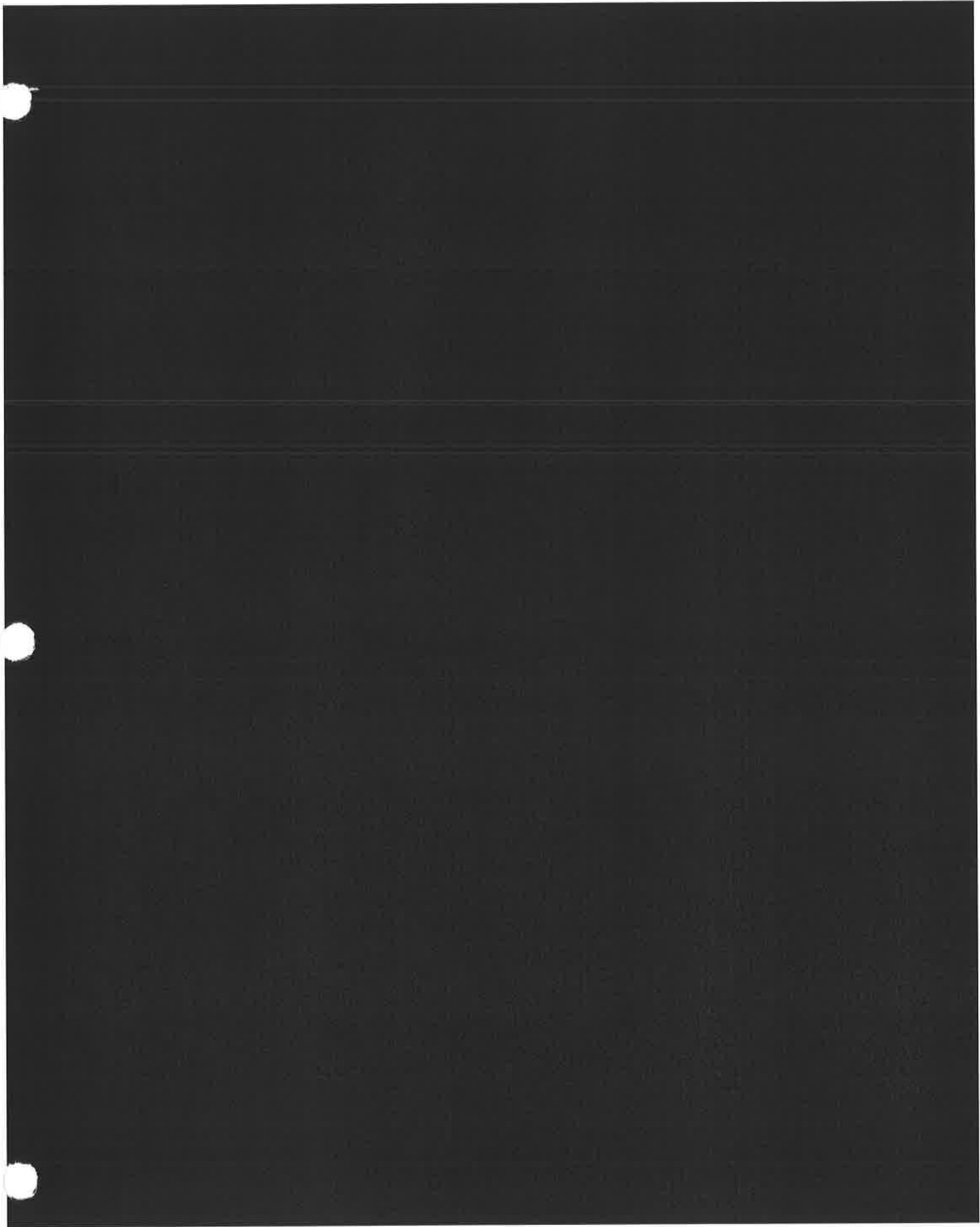

Dear Mr. Anderson:

Enclosed are the original and two copies of the proposed agreement providing for pastoral counselling benefits.

The agreement form was previously approved and used by your office. Would you please assure that [REDACTED] understands that this is a voluntary payment program by St. John's consistent with its policy against sexual abuse and that the benefits are extended without any requirement that responsibility be established. As a matter of fact, St. John's is relying upon your very sketchy description of the alleged incident and your follow-up letter advising that counseling benefits are necessary.

I also expect that [REDACTED] and his family will understand that St. John's cannot commit to an open ended obligation when it has no information regarding the planned or recommended course of treatment, its frequency, cost and duration. You will note that a provision has been included allowing for reconsideration by St. John's, in its discretion.

I fail to see the basis for your objection to providing treatment records or notes relating to the services for which payment is requested. If, as you have indicated, [REDACTED] decides to pursue a claim against the various entities and persons identified by you, any privilege attached to those treatment records will be waived. If his decision is not to pursue a claim, he is assured that the confidentiality of those records will be respected and maintained. St. John's has no intention of becoming involved in directing or controlling the

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Agreement records the agreement of pastoral assistance offered and provided by St. John's Abbey to [REDACTED] for payment of counseling and treatment expenses related to the claims and conditions described in the February 21, 1996 letter of attorney Jeffrey Anderson. The parties agree that this Memorandum and the future payment for counseling expenses are not admissions of any wrongful act by St. John's Abbey, its related organizations or any of its members or any other person and are not admissible as evidence of liability or fault against St. John's Abbey, its related organizations or any of its members or any other person in any legal action. Further, in the event of any settlement or judgment resulting from the above referenced action which includes compensation for such expenses previously paid by St. John's Abbey, the Abbey will be entitled to a credit to the extent of its prior duplicative payments.

1. St. John's Abbey will pay for previously unpaid and future reasonable counseling and treatment expenses not covered by insurance available to [REDACTED] owing to Dr. [REDACTED] for professional services relating to incidents of alleged sexual abuse provided through March 1, 1997 in an amount not to exceed the sum of \$2,500.00. Should it be established that the duration and cost of necessary treatment will exceed the above limitations, St. John's may, in its sole discretion, agree to increase the duration and/or amount of pastoral benefits.

2. [REDACTED] shall be obligated to request, authorize and direct Dr. [REDACTED], or other involved health care providers to provide St. John's Abbey on a timely basis with treatment records detailing and substantiating the services provided. St. John's Abbey shall request records in writing through its attorneys, which request shall be forwarded to attorneys for [REDACTED] for processing. At no time prior to commencement of an action may St. John's Abbey make a direct request for records from Dr. [REDACTED], or other involved health care providers, or speak with him, or other health care providers, directly, regarding the treatment of [REDACTED]. In no event shall St. John's Abbey be required pursuant to this agreement to pay expenses primarily or exclusively generated and incurred for purposes of preparation to testify or for testimony by Dr. [REDACTED] or other health care providers, in the above identified claim or lawsuit. Only necessary and reasonable treatment expenses are covered by this agreement.

3. This agreement supersedes and extinguishes any other prior agreements and understandings between the parties relating to the payment of such treatment expenses. In the event of an agreement to settle or entry of a money judgment in the above described lawsuit, this Agreement and all obligations of the parties pursuant to it shall automatically terminate unless the parties agree otherwise in writing.

Please keep this in mind as to your further therapy with [REDACTED] and once we get near this amount, we need to review this matter.

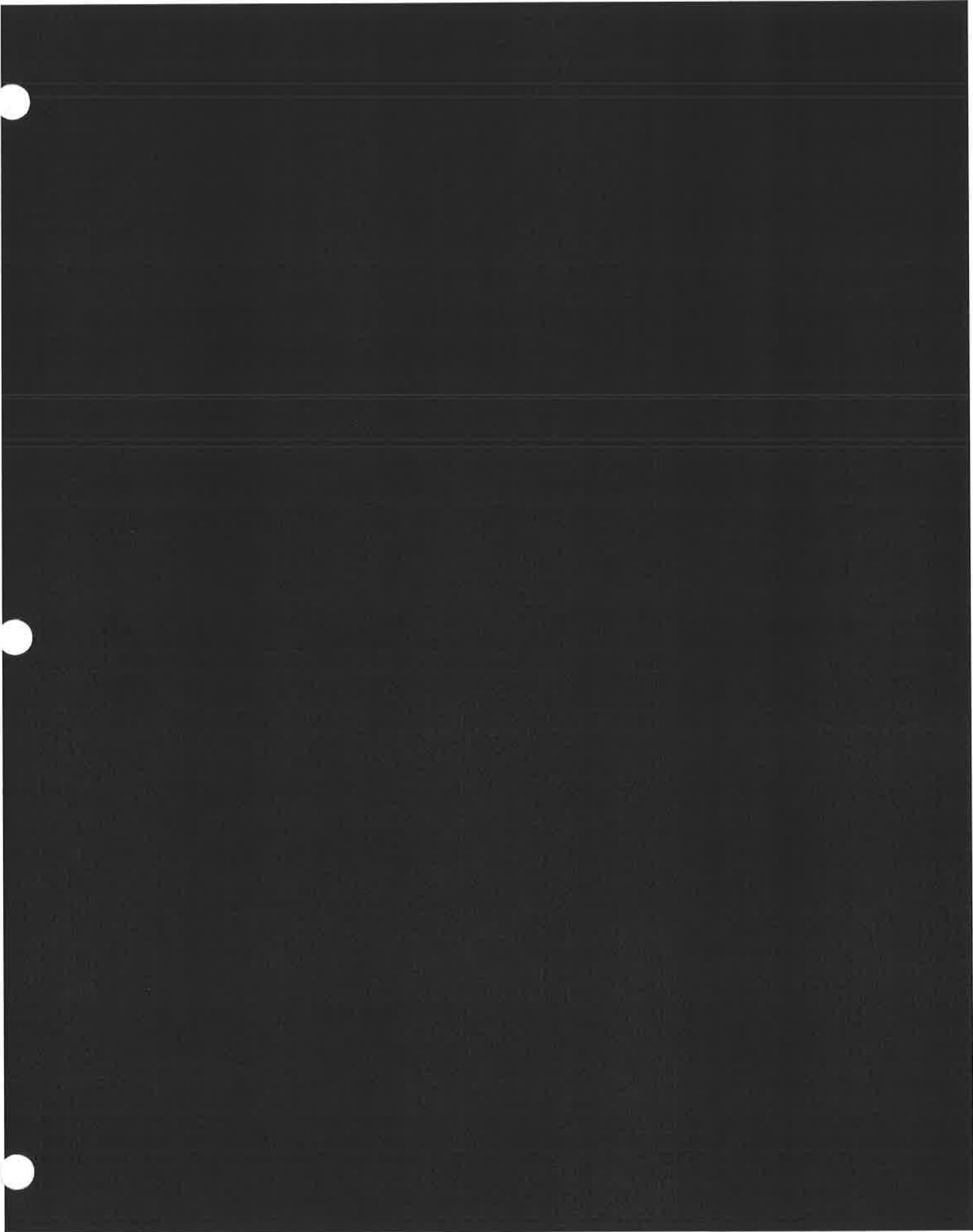
